

A Time to Harvest

Ecclesiastes 3:2 says, "there is a time to plant, and a time to harvest." This year, Global Renewal has been in a season of harvesting. Already this year we have been on three major international trips. We have seen close to 1,000 people commit their lives to Jesus, we have seen thousands healed and delivered, and we have had major developments in our ministry everywhere we are working. We have plowed and planted, and now we are harvesting more than ever before. The ministry is growing quickly and we are so excited to share this good news with you!

IN JANUARY I took a team to Butaleja, Uganda to preach a crusade and launch a church. Before the trip, I was warned by my Ugandan friends that Butaleja is too difficult. They told me it is the worst witchcraft they had ever seen, It is majority Muslim, and even the Anglicans are against us. They asked if we could move to a different city. When I heard all of that, I got excited because I know that light shines brightest in the darkest places. I told them not to worry, but to simply pray. When we arrived in Butaleja, everything was easy. The enemy is no match for our God! People came to Christ easily. On that trip alone we had almost 500 people make first time decisions for Christ! I have never seen such openness to the Gospel among Muslims. Almost every Muslim who heard the Gospel repented and accepted Jesus. We baptized many of them in water and they even changed their names! On the third night of the crusade I preached on the power that is in the name of Jesus. After the preaching we began to pray and we watched as over 1,000 people in one night were completely healed in their bodies and dozens were delivered from demons. Even a local witchdoctor, after seeing the power that is in Jesus, repented of her witchcraft, was delivered from demons, and baptized in water. The church was planted in Butaleja and has been thriving ever since.

IN FEBRUARY we visited one of our rescue homes in Delhi, India. That home alone has rescued over 3,000 girls between the ages of 5 and 17 from human trafficking. Increasingly we have also been rescuing girls from organ trafficking. Girls are being kidnapped in order to take their organs while they are still alive to sell to rich customers on the black market. We thank God that we have been able to rescue girls from this horrible fate. My favorite day from this trip was when we took all 55 girls who are living in the home, as well as 30 girls from the prevention program to the amusement park. It was such a blessing to see these girls play and have fun, and just be kids.

IN MARCH we were in Mombasa, Kenya making plans to expand our church planting and rescue ministry to the coastal region of Kenya, which is the Muslim area of Kenya. This trip was special because my whole family came with me and I got to see my kids evangelizing. We are planning our first crusade and church plant in Mombasa next year where we believe hundreds of Muslims will hear the Gospel and accept Jesus as their Lord!

IN BETWEEN all of these trips, I have been preaching every weekend, and often for multiple day events focused on revival in churches in America. I have seen an increase in the move of the Spirit in America as well. It seems that miracles are happening more frequently than ever. Blind eyes opening, deaf ears hearing, all manner of sickness and pain leaving, and the most amazing miracle of all, people are repenting of their sins and turning to Jesus at an increasing rate.

We must reap this harvest while it is ripe!

This is 12 year old Daphne. During the second day of the crusade in Butaleja, Daphne came and found me in the church building with an interpreter. She came right up to me and told me that she had to talk to me. She had heard of the miracles happening in the crusade and she needed God to work a miracle for her. She began to tell me her story. She told me how she was raised by her aunt and grandpa who were heavily into witchcraft and demon worship. She told me of the ritual abuse she had endured since she was an infant. She informed me that her grandfather had cursed her and tied something around her waist when she was very small as part of the curse. This string had been around her waste for her entire life. I told her that Jesus was going to set her free and I had a young lady take her to the bathroom and cut the string off of her waist. When they came back with the string, I set it on fire. As soon as it started to burn Daphne began manifesting demons, talking in different voices and thrashing on the floor. We prayed over her and the demons came out, she was born again, and baptized in the Holy Spirit at the same moment. I watched as this little girl went from an empty shell of a person to the most joyful kid in town in an instant. From that moment on Daphne followed us everywhere we went, and she is now living with the pastor of the church. This is why we do what we do, because we know that our God is madly in love with Daphne, and that Jesus died on a cross for her to be delivered and brought into His family.
