

Across the street and around the world!

Sometimes us missionaries talk about being "on the field." This phrase has become synonymous with being in a foreign country. The truth is that all of you who are reading this newsletter are on a mission field every day. When you go to work, when you wave at your neighbors, when you go to the grocery store, there are lost and hurting people around us daily who desperately need to experience the love of Jesus. Our mission as the church of Jesus is to reach those lost and hurting people, whether they be across the street or around the world.

In May I was able to finally go overseas and reach the lost in Uganda. I saw the family of a witch doctor surrender to Jesus and be healed and baptized in the Holy Spirit. I saw countless salvations, healings, deliverances, baptisms in the Holy Spirit, and miracles. We even planted a new church which will continue to reach many more people. Equally exciting to me in this season are the people who are coming to Jesus in my local area. People like George who was a self-professed agnostic, who came to our house church for the first time three weeks ago out of curiosity. After I prayed for him, he accepted Christ the first night there. Last week was his third time at the church gathering in our home and he was baptized in the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues. I am excited about people like Mike whose testimony you will read on the back page of this letter. I prayed with him to surrender his life to Christ just one year ago, and he has grown so radically that a local church offered him a position as their youth pastor. There is a deep passion in my heart for foreign missions and I am eagerly awaiting my next trip to plant another church in Uganda, God willing in February. I am equally passionate about seeing the church of America awaken and be trained to reach the lost across the street! The Car Accident

On our way back from planting our new church in Serere, Uganda, we witnessed a horrific car accident directly in front of us on the highway. I told my driver to pull over and I jumped out and ran as fast as I could to the driver who was bleeding out on the pavement. It was clear to me that he probably only had moments left. I was not sure if he could hear me, but I knelt next to him and told him that Jesus died so that he could be forgiven and welcomed into Heaven. I pleaded with him to accept Christ. I cannot be sure if this was a coincidence but as I told him to put his hope in Jesus he turned and lifted his hand as much as he could. I can only hope that he was responding to the Gospel. I stayed with him praying until he was loaded into a car to be taken to the hospital. The police informed us later that they heard there was an accident and that the driver had died. I thank God for the opportunity to share Jesus with him one last time.

I walked back to our car and my ministry partner in Uganda said, "We have to go let's get in the car." I replied, " You can get in the car I'm not done yet." The devil was not going to win. I stood up and asked for everyone's attention and preached the Gospel to about 50 people who were standing there. Many prayed to receive Christ. One of the team members took this picture as I was preaching to them. With so many amazing testimonies from this last trip it was hard to pick one. I chose this one to say that even in tragedy, the love of Jesus still prevails.


What a privilege it is to be part of the body of Christ and to work together with you all to bring in a harvest. Thank you all for sending us across the street and around the world through your prayers and giving!
